

Preparation

Thank you for purchasing the **LVLA**. This Product is part of the Body-Solid line of quality strength training machines, which lets you target specific muscle groups to achieve better muscle tone and overall body conditioning. To maximize your use of the equipment please study this Owner's Manual thoroughly.

Required Tools

The basic tools that you must obtain before assembling the LVLA include but are not limited to:

- O Standard Wrench Set
- O Metric Wrench Set
- O Adjustable Wrench

Installation Requirements

Follow these installation requirements when assembling the **LVLA**:

Set up the **LVLA** on a solid, flat surface. A smooth, flatsurface under the machine helps keep it level. A level machine has fewer malfunctions.

Provide ample space around the machine. Open space around the machine allows for easier access.

Insert all bolts in the same direction. For aesthetic purposes, insert all bolts in the same direction unless specified (in text or illustrations) to do otherwise.

Leave room for adjustments. Tighten fasteners such as bolts, nuts, and screws so the unit is stable, but leave room for adjustments. Do not fully tighten fasteners until instructed in the assembly steps to do so.

Fill out and mail the warranty card.

Assembly Tips


Read all "Notes" on each page before beginning each step.

While you may be able to assemble the **LVLA** using the illustrations only, important safety notes and other tips are included in the text.

Some pieces may have extra holes that you will not use. Use only those holes indicated in the instructions and illustrations.

NOTE: With so many assembled parts, proper alignment and adjustment is critical. While tightening the nuts and bolts, be sure to leave room for adjustments.

CAUTION: Obtain assistance! If you feel like you can't assemble the **LVLA** by yourself then do not attempt to do so as this could result in injury. Review the installation requirements before proceeding with the following steps.



- **1A.** Attach Front & Rear Main Frame (**A & C**) to Middle Main Frame (**B**) using:
 - 2 (#1) M12x110mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 (#2) M12x85mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 12 (#12) M12 Washer
 - 6 (#21) M12 Nylon Lock Nut
- **1B.** Attach Foot Plate **(D)** to Front Main Frame **(A)** using:
 - 2 (#5) M10x70mm Button Head Cap Screw
 - 4 (#14) M10 Washer
 - 2 (#22) M10 Nylon Lock Nut
- 1C. Attach Foot Pads (#26) to Main Frames (A, B & C).






Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten until instructed. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tightened to fully go on.

- **2A.** Attach Lower Lever Arms (K & H) to Center Main Frame (B) using:
 - 2 (#7) M10x20mm Button Head Cap Screw
 - 2 (#14) M10 Washer
 - 2 (#15) M10 Lock Washer
 - 2 (#29) ø51xø10.2mm Washer
 - 4 (#30) Bearing
 - 2 (#31) ø51xø25.5mm Washer
- 2B. Attach Weight Horns (J) to Lower Lever Arms (K & H).
- 2C. Insert Rubber Donuts (#27) onto Weight Horns (J).






NOTE:

Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 3B. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

- **3A.** Attach Upper Lever Arms (M & N) to Center Main Frame (B) using:
 - 2 (#7) M10x20mm Button Head Cap Screw
 - 2 (#14) M10 Washer
 - 2 (#15) M10 Lock Washer
 - 2 (#29) ø51xø10.2mm Washer
 - 4 (#30) Bearing
 - 2 (#31) ø51xø25.5mm Washer
- **3B.** Attach Chrome Rods (L) with Ball Join Rod Ends (#37) to Lever Arms (H, K, M, N) using:
 - 4 (#11) M16 Lock Washer
 - 4 (#20) M16 Acorn Nut



Above shows Step 3 assembled and completed.



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


NOTE:

Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 4A. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

- 4A. Attach Storage Weight Horns (G) to Center Main Frame (B) using:
 - 8 (#3) M12x80mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 16 (#12) M12 Washer
 - 8 (#21) M12 Nylon Lock Nut
- 4B. Insert Rubber Donuts (#27) onto Storage Weight Horns (G).








NOTE:

Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 5E. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.


- **5A.** Insert Seat Post (**E**) into Front Main Frame (**A**).
- **5B.** Attach Seat Pad (#23) to Seat Post (E) using:
 - 4 (#9) M8x30mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 (#17) M8 Lock Washer
 - 4 (#16) M8 Washer
- **5C.** Insert Knee Post (F) into Front Main Frame (A).
- **5D.** Attach Knee Pads (#25) to Knee Post (F) using:
 - 4 (#8) M8x50mm Button Head Cap Screw
 - 4 (#17) M8 Lock Washer
 - 4 (#16) M8 Washer
- 5E. Insert Pop Pins (#24) into Front Main Frame (A).
