Preparation

Thank you for purchasing the **S2AC**. This bench is part of the Body-Solid line of quality strength training machines, which lets you target specific muscle groups to achieve better muscle tone and overall body conditioning. To maximize your use of the equipment please study this Owner's Manual thoroughly.

Required Tools

The basic tools that you must obtain before assembling the **S2AC** include but are not limited to:

- O Metric Allen Key Set
- O Standard Allen Key Set
- Standard Wrench Set
- O Metric Wrench Set
- Adjustable Wrench
- O Screwdriver (standard and/or phillips)

Installation Requirements

Follow these installation requirements when assembling the **S2AC**:

Set up the **S2AC** on a solid, flat surface. A smooth, flat surface under the machine helps keep it level. A level machine has fewer malfunctions.

Provide ample space around the machine. Open space around the machine allows for easier access.

Insert all bolts in the same direction. For aesthetic purposes, insert all bolts in the same direction unless specified (in text or illustrations) to do otherwise.

Leave room for adjustments. Tighten fasteners such as bolts, nuts, and screws so the unit is stable, but leave room for adjustments. Do not fully tighten fasteners until instructed in the assembly steps to do so.

Fill out and mail the warranty card.


Assembly Tips

Some pieces may have extra holes that you will not use. Use only those holes indicated in the instructions and illustrations.

- **NOTE:** With so many assembled parts, proper alignment and adjustment is critical. While tightening the nuts and bolts, be sure to leave room for adjustments.
- **NOTE:** The bottles that are marked "Poison" is your touch up paint. Keep away from children.
- **CAUTION:** Obtain assistance! If you feel like you can't assemble the **S2AC** by yourself then do not attempt to do so as this could result in injury. Review the installation requirements before proceeding with the following steps.






STEP

Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten unless instructed. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

- 1A. Attach Frame A (A) to Frame B (B) using:
 2 (#7) M10X80mm Hex Head Bolt
 4 (#51) 11mmX20mm Flat Washer
 2 (#40) M10 Nylon Lock Nut
- 1B. Attach Frame C (C) to Frame A (A) using:
 2 (#2) M10X105mm Hex Head Bolt
 4 (#51) 11mmX20mm Flat Washer
 2 (#40) M10 Nylon Lock Nut
- 1C. Attach Frame E (E) to Frame A (A) using:
 2 (#3) M10X25mm Hex Head Bolt
 2 (#51) 11mmX20mm Flat Washer
- **1D.** Attach Frame E (E) to Frame C (C) using:
 - 2 (#2) M10X105mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 4 (#51) 11mmX20mm Flat Washer
 - 2 (#40) M10 Nylon Lock Nut
- **1E.** Attach Frame D (D) to Frame C (C) and Frame B (B) using:
 - 4 (#8) M10X80mm Hex Head Bolt
 - 8 (#51) 11mmX20mm Flat Washer
 - 4 (#40) M10 Nylon Lock Nut



step 2



NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware in this step. DO NOT wrench tighten unless instructed. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

2A. Attach Frame A (A) to Weight Stack Frame (WA) using:

- 4 (#8) M12X35mm Hex Head Bolt
- 8 (#52) 13mmX24mm Flat Washer
- 4 (#41) M12 Nylon Lock Nut





Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware first in this step. Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 3B. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

3A. Attach Arm Frame (F) to Frame C (C) using:


- 2 (#1) M10X25mm Flat Head Cap Screw
- 1 (#66) 25mmX137mm Shaft Pin
- 2 (#76) 38mm Cap

Note: 1) Please make sure the key slot of the Shaft Pin is aligned with the key slot hole of Frame C.

2) You may need to use a mallet when inserting the Shaft Pin.

3B. Attach Handle (J) to Arm Frame (F) using:

- 1 (#1) M10X25mm Flat Head Cap Screw
- 1 (#76) 38mm Cap
- 1 (#9) M10X20 Socket Head Screw



step 4

Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware first in this step. Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 4G. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.


4A. Install Chrome Guide Rods (WD) into the holes in the Weight Stack Frame (WA).

Note: Install the ends of rods with side holes into the bottom section of the Weight Stack Frame.

- **4B.** Install Rubber Donuts (**#79**) and slide to the bottom of the Guide Rods
- **4C.** Tilt Guide Rods **(WD)** away from the Weight Stack Frame **(WA)** and install 15pcs of weight plates **(#60)**. Be careful to hold guide rods steadily when installing weight plates.

Note: Please make sure the grooves of the weight plates are faced down during installation.

- **4D.** Install Top Plate & Selector Rod Assembly **(#18, #55, #61, #62)** onto the Guide Rods . Install the Top Plate Bolt **(#63)**, the Lock Nut **(#44)** and the Spring Washer **(#56)**.
- **4E.** Install Shaft Collars **(#81)** onto the Guide Rods so they are directly below the guide rod holes in the upper section of the Weight Stack Frame.
- **4F.** Slide Shaft Collars **(#81)** upward so they lock the guide rods into position by tightening the Set Screws **(#12)**
- **4G.** Install Weight Stack Pin (**#70**) using the key ring end through the Selector Rod Top Bolt (**#63**).



step 5

Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.


NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware first in this step. Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 5D. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.

5A. Install seven Pulleys **(#84)** into frames as shown in Step 5 Drawing using:

7 - (#6) M10X50mm Hex Head Bolt 14 - (#51) 11X20mm Flat Washer 7 - (#40) M10 Nylon Lock Nut

- **5B.** Install Cable **(#88)** by first assembling the ball end into the Selector Rod Top Bolt **(#63)** and attaching the Cable Cylinder Lock **(#64)** over the ball end of the cable. Secure it by tighten in the set Screw **(#11)**
- **5C.** Install the M10X35mm Hex Head Bolt **(#5)** through the slot hole of the Selector Rod Top Bolt **(#63)** by fastening the Nylon Lock Nut **(#40)**
- 5D. Route Cable (#88) as shown in Step 5 Drawing. Put the end of the Cable through the hole of the Cam (F). Install the Quick Cable Lock (#74) at the end of the cable. Install the Nylon Cap (#85) onto the hole of Cam (F)



STEP 6

Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.

NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware first in this step. Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 6B. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.


6A. Attach Short Metal Shrouds (**WB**) and Long Metal Shrouds (**WC**) to Weight Stack Frame (**WA**) using:

4 - (#16) M8X25mm Button Head Cap Screw

8 - (#54) 9mmX16mm Flat Washer

4 - (#43) M8 Nylon Lock Nut

- **6B.** Bend the Plastic Shrouds (WE & WF) and insert them to the side slots of the Metal Shrouds (WB & WC).
- 6C. Attach Top Shroud (WG) to Weight Stack Frame (WA) using:
 - 3 (#13) M6X16mm Phillps Head Screw
 - 3 (#53) 6.6X12mm Flat Washer





Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.



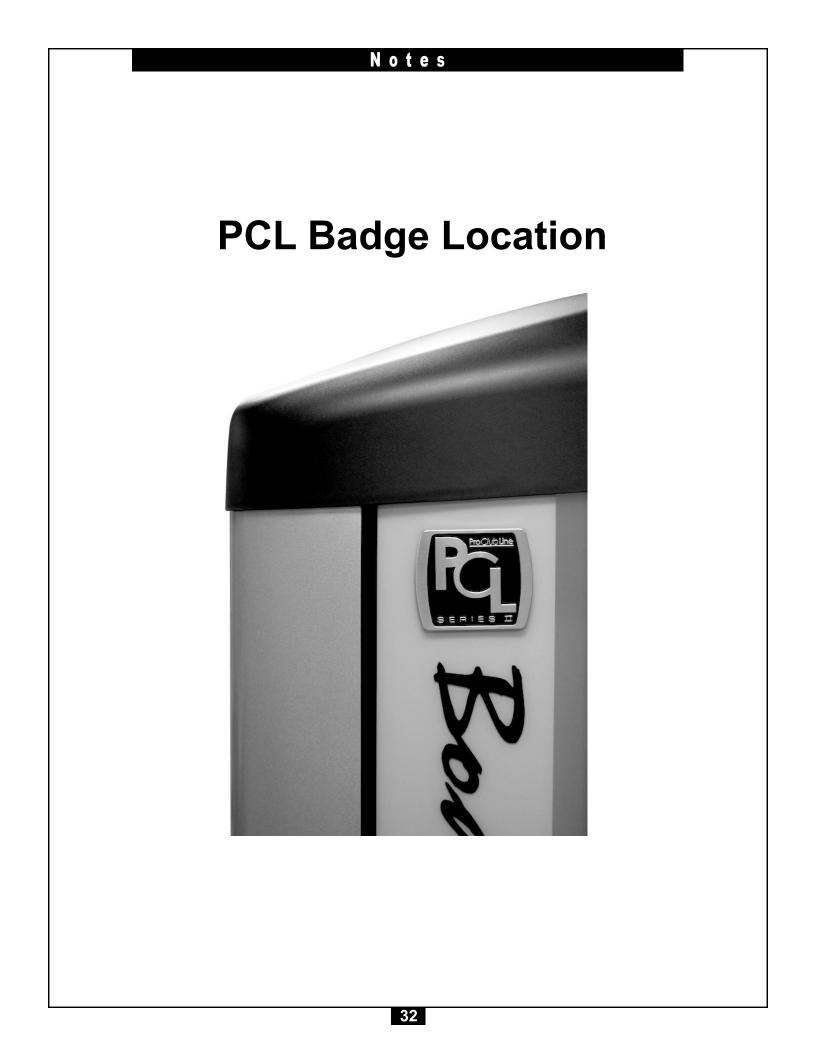


